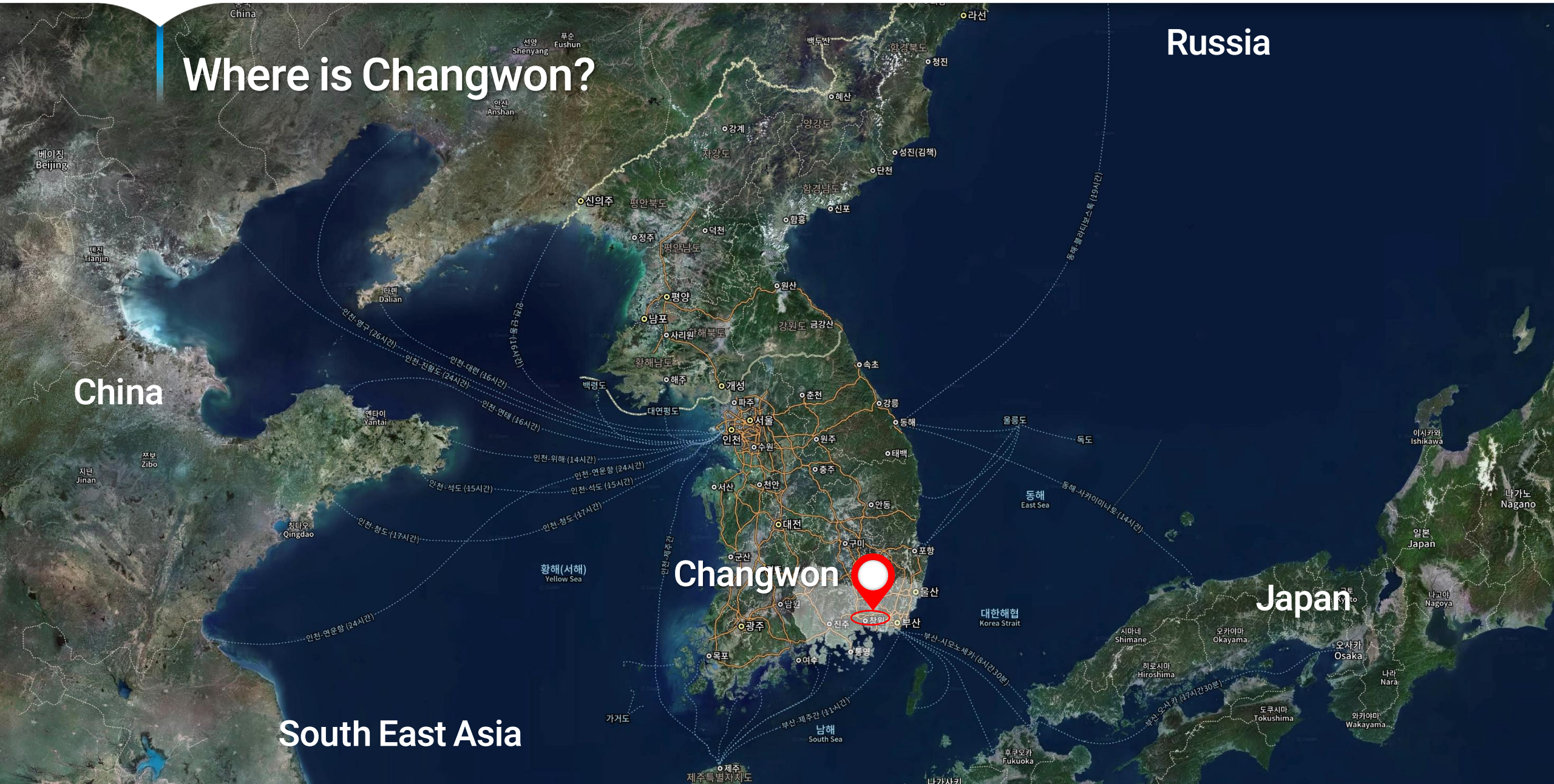


Where is Changwon?
